## Update from Head of School

Alhamdulillah, we have successfully completed our first set of professional development classes focused on Islam's theory and approach towards the sciences for all our teachers and staff. This course was designed to address the question of whether all sciences can be categorized as Islamic. In an effort to answer this question, the course provided a brief framework on how to approach teaching these sciences to our students. To truly create an Islamic education system, it is not enough to simply add Islamic law and theology classes to the American school curriculum. An Islamic approach to education seeks to impart *tawhid* to the seekers of knowledge and create an environment that nurtures the soul to see the signs of God all around.

#### **Current Updates**

Phase I renovations are nearly complete. As shown in the attached photos, the multi-purpose facility is almost finished. This hall will serve as a gathering space for prayers, religious programming, assembly hall, dining hall, and classroom. The building is approximately 1,600 square feet and will be equipped with many features including but not limited to a state-of-the-art AV system, basic plumbing, and dedicated prayer and dining spaces.. We intend to finish all the work on it and make it ready by the first of Muharram, insha'Allah.
